

ATTENTION ALL SOCCER PEOPLE
WHO USE MACARTHUR FIELD:

Construction of the California State Veterans Home on the West LA campus is scheduled to begin July 9th, 2007 with completion anticipated in December, 2009. The California Department of Veterans Affairs will construct a 396-bed long-term care facility for veterans and their spouses that will provide the following levels of care: skilled nursing, skilled nursing/dementia and Alzheimer's, and assisted living. Once construction commences on July 9th a fence will be erected around the site of the State Home (the location of the State Home is indicated by the shaded red area below).

This mainly affects those of you who enter from the WEST entrances to the VA off of Bringham Ave. (the street outside the VA grounds on the bottom of the picture). For those entering from the West, please note that the typical path to the field using MacArthur Ave. will now be closed and so you must cut across the VA to Bonsall Ave and then go North to the field. All visitors to MacArthur field must now enter and exit the field parking lot (Lot 38) from/to Bonsall Ave which intersects MacArthur Ave at the entrance to Lot 38 and runs North/South from Wilshire Blvd. The photo below shows the construction area in red. FYI, MacArthur Field is on the far left of the picture at the north end of Lot 38.
